Green Waste

We will separately collect Green Waste at curbside on your regular collection day. Trimmings, clippings and branches should be in a separate container (no plastic bags please) or bundled for collection.

Community Clean-Up

The 1st City-wide Clean-Up of 2010 will be held January 25 – 30. Place your discards and extra waste at the curb by 6 AM, Monday, January 25th, for collection during the week. (You do not need to call for pick-up.)

OR, bring your materials to the FREE drop-off location at the City's Corporation Yard at the West end of Hacienda Blvd. on **Saturday, January 30th, 8 AM - 2 PM.**

Remember to contact a local charity if your discards are still useful to someone else.

PLEASE NOTE.....the drop-off site is for DHS residents ONLY. Please be prepared to produce proof of residency, such as your

driver's license AND a utility bill. Construction waste will NOT be accepted at this event.

The next quarterly clean-up will be during the 4th week of April.

Christmas Tree Recycling

We will collect and recycle Christmas trees on regular trash collection days. Remove all decorations and cut large trees into 4-foot lengths and place out for collection as Green Waste.

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents may dispose of paint, pesticides and any common household hazardous waste every non-holiday Saturday, from 9 AM to 2 PM. The facility is located at 1100 Vella Road, Palm Springs, just south of E. Mesquite Avenue. For more information, visit:
