[FREE Curbside Clean Up](#)

Our next community-wide clean up for residents of single-family dwellings in Desert Hot Springs will start Monday, January 21st.

- This is a **FREE curbside ONLY** event. You do not need to contact us to arrange collection.
- There are limits to how much we will collect:
 - Two (2) bulky items, **OR**
 - Four (4) 32-gallon containers of excess trash, **OR**
 - Two (2) tied bundles of yard waste weighing less than 50-lbs.
- Place your waste items at the curb **by 6:00 A.M., Monday, January 21st**.

Our crews will make one pass through the City during the week collecting these materials.

As a reminder, please donate reusable items to a community organization; many offer collection.

[Do Not Put Trash In Recycling Carts](#)

We ask you to exercise care and discretion with recycling. When we find recycling carts that contain trash, we will leave them behind uncollected. The recycling carts of repeat offenders will be removed from service. Should you need a second trash cart, we will be happy to provide it for a charge. Please call for details.

As a reminder, we will gladly collect and recycle natural Christmas trees.

Simply remove decorations and stands, cut the trees into 4-foot sections and place at the curb on your regular collection day.

2019 Holiday Collection Schedule

We will observe the following Holidays in 2019:

New Year's Day	Tuesday, January 1
Memorial Day	Monday, May 27
Independence Day	Thursday, July 4
Labor Day, Monday	September 2
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 28
Christmas Day	Wednesday, December 25

Collections scheduled on a holiday and the remaining days of that week will occur one day late.



Mandatory Construction & Demolition Debris Recycling

The Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code requires property owners and contractors to divert construction and demolition debris from the landfill. The Municipal Code requires applicants to file a plan, a surety guarantee, and a final report proving diversion. We are authorized by the City to help you streamline the process and bypass the 'plan-surety-reporting' requirements. Call for details.

Lower Prices on Debris Boxes

During January, February and March we are continuing discounted pricing for debris boxes used for the removal and recycling of construction and demolition debris. Take advantage of reduced rates for 20-, 30- or 40-CY boxes. Call for details.



Mandatory Commercial Recycling

State law (AB 341) requires all commercial establishments to arrange for recycling. We can assist your business with these arrangements, many times at no additional cost. Call for details.

Mandatory Organic Waste Recycling

State law (AB 1826) requires commercial establishments that generate 4 or more cubic yards of organic waste to arrange for recycling of organic waste. The term "organic waste" means food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste. We can assist your business with these services. (Multi-family properties ARE NOT REQUIRED to separate food waste BUT ARE REQUIRED to recycle plant material.) Call for details.
